## State Laws and Other Regulatory Policies Related to Pain Care

This project compiles identified language from state laws and other regulatory policies governing pain treatment, including for palliative care and end-of-life care that were active as of December 31, 2017. This dataset explores important features of state pain care-related laws and other regulatory policies. It includes laws and policies that address prescribing of controlled substances (specifically, Schedule II opioid analgesics); definitions creating parameters for healthcare practice; standards for evaluating and improving pain treatment, including practitioner expectations for treatment; practice requirements; and characteristics of state prescription drug monitoring programs (PDMPs).
